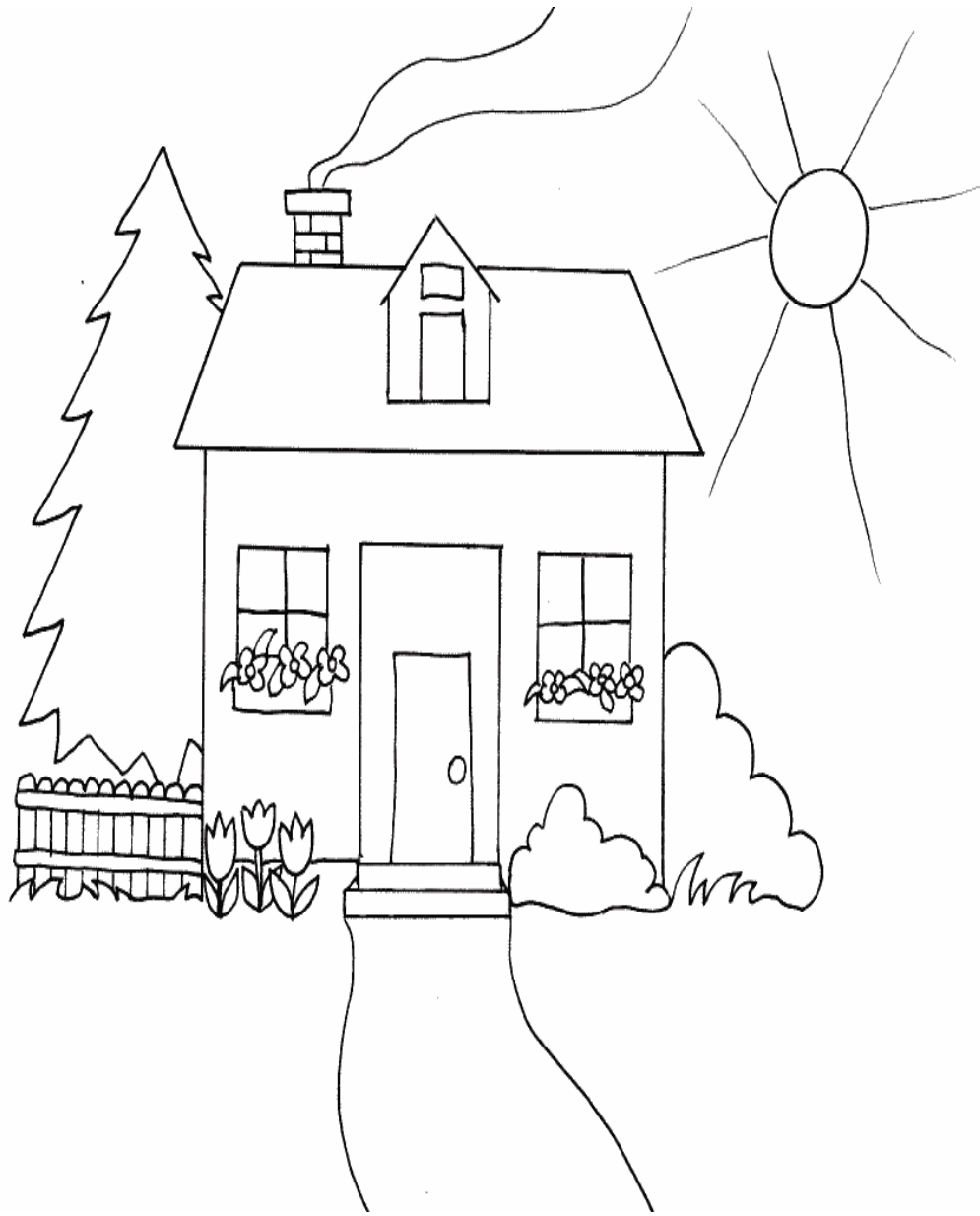

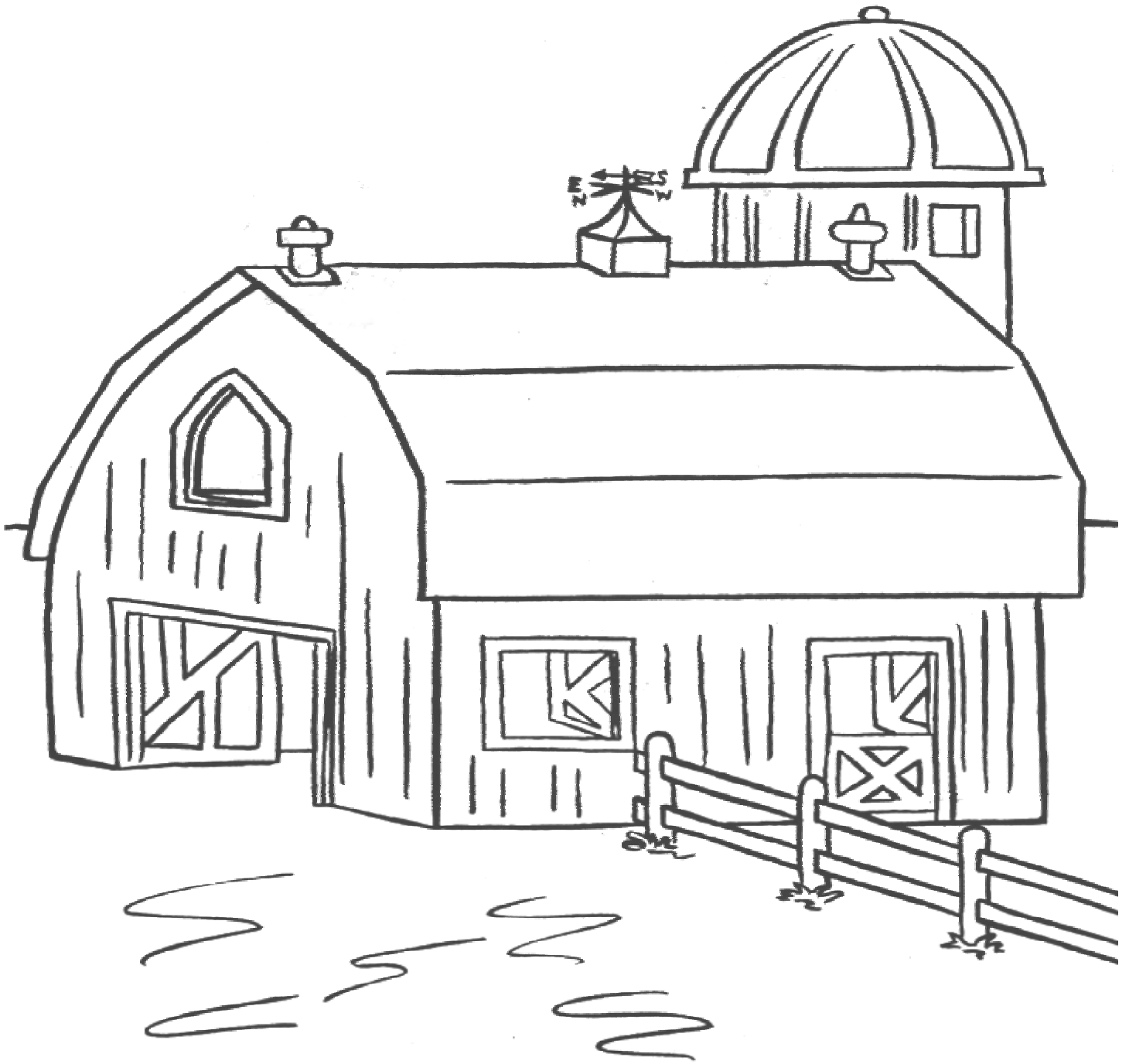


Everyone is different.

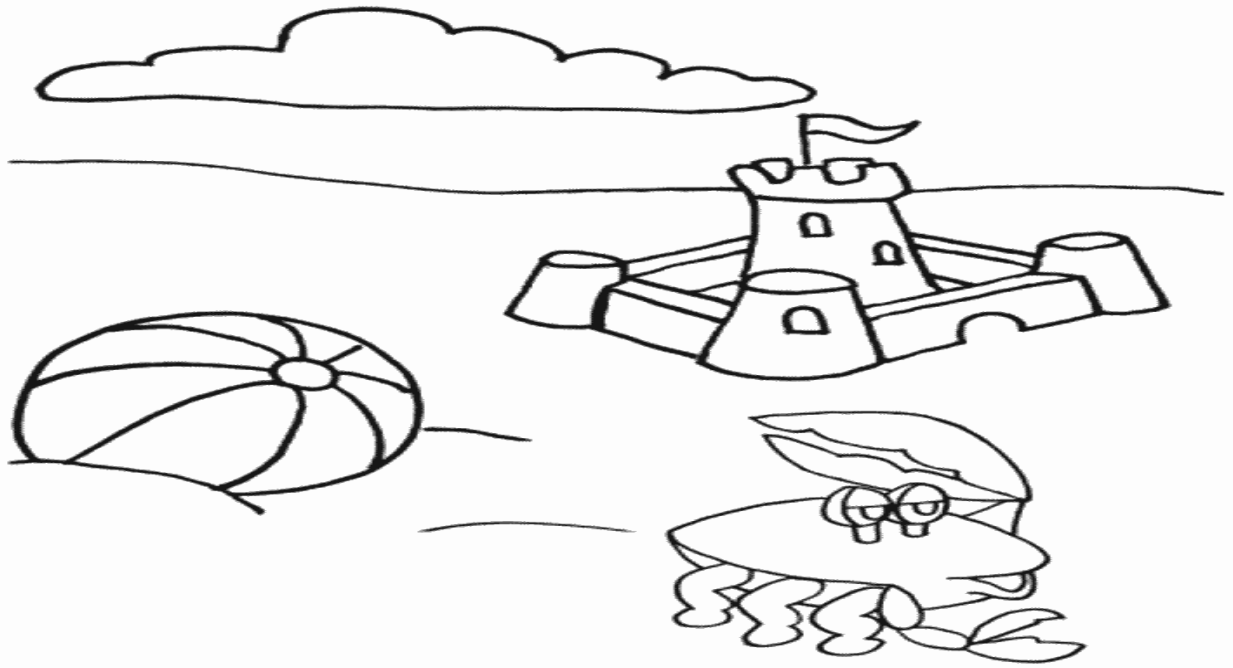
We live in different places.



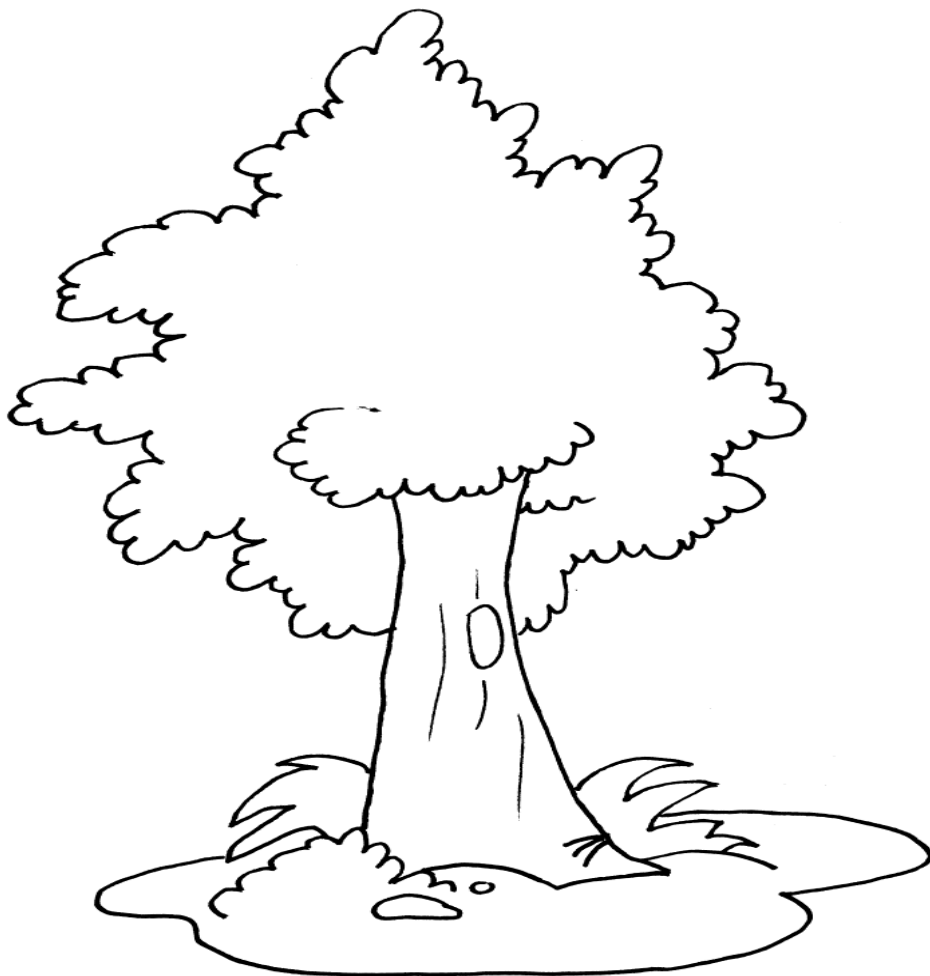
Some of us live in the city.

Some people live near the water.

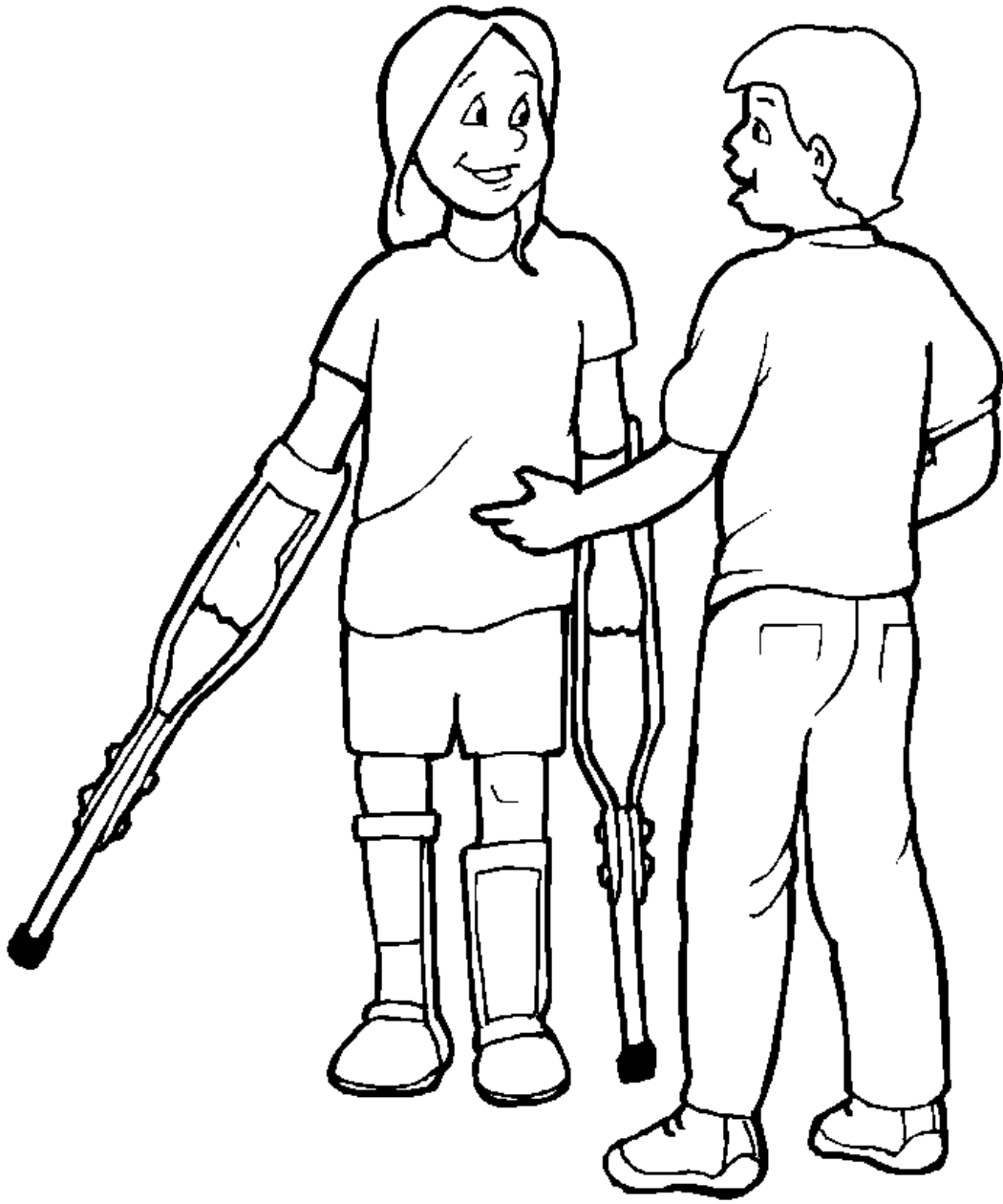


Some people live near
the forests.

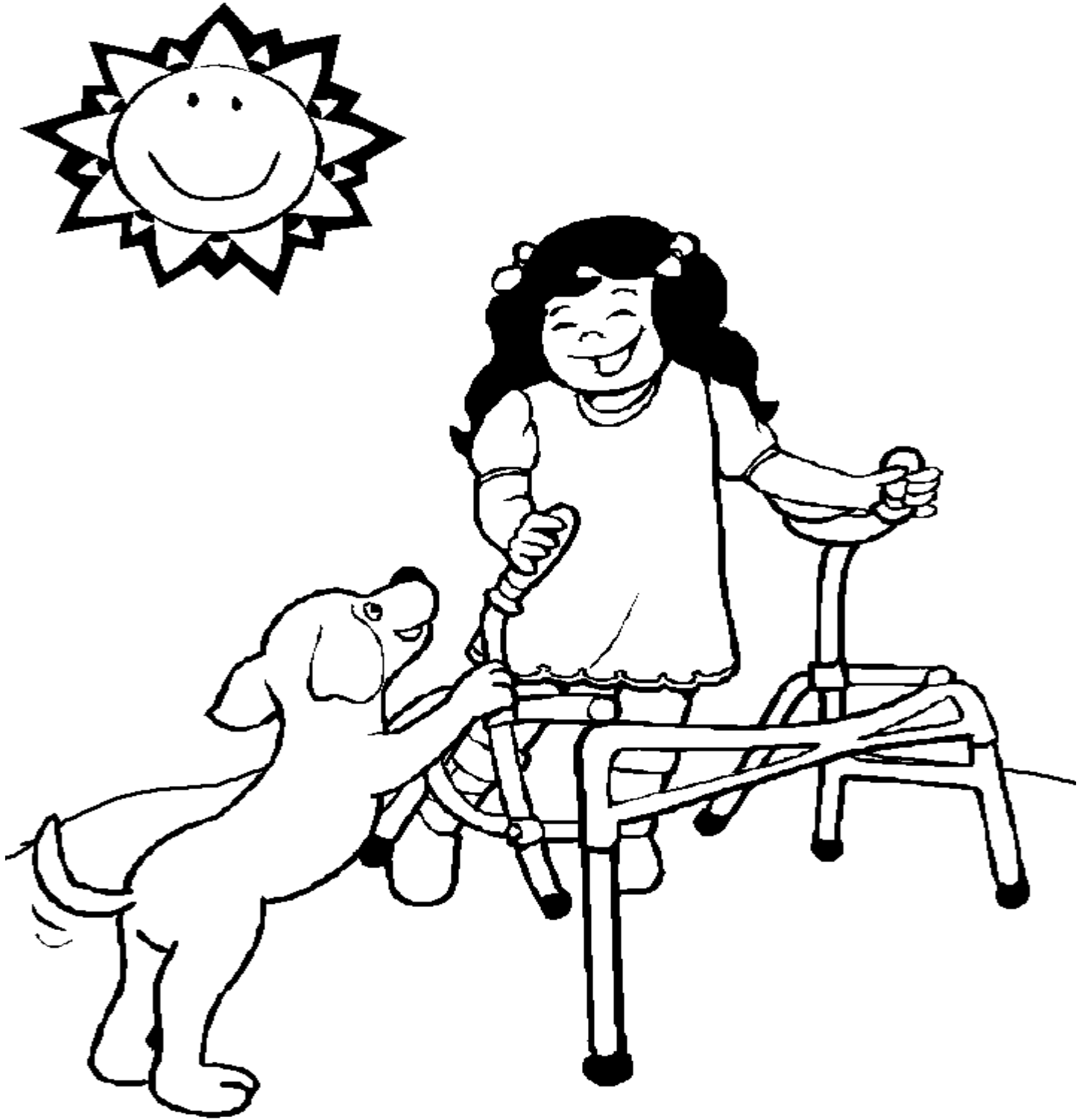


Children are different too.

Some children have **green** eyes,

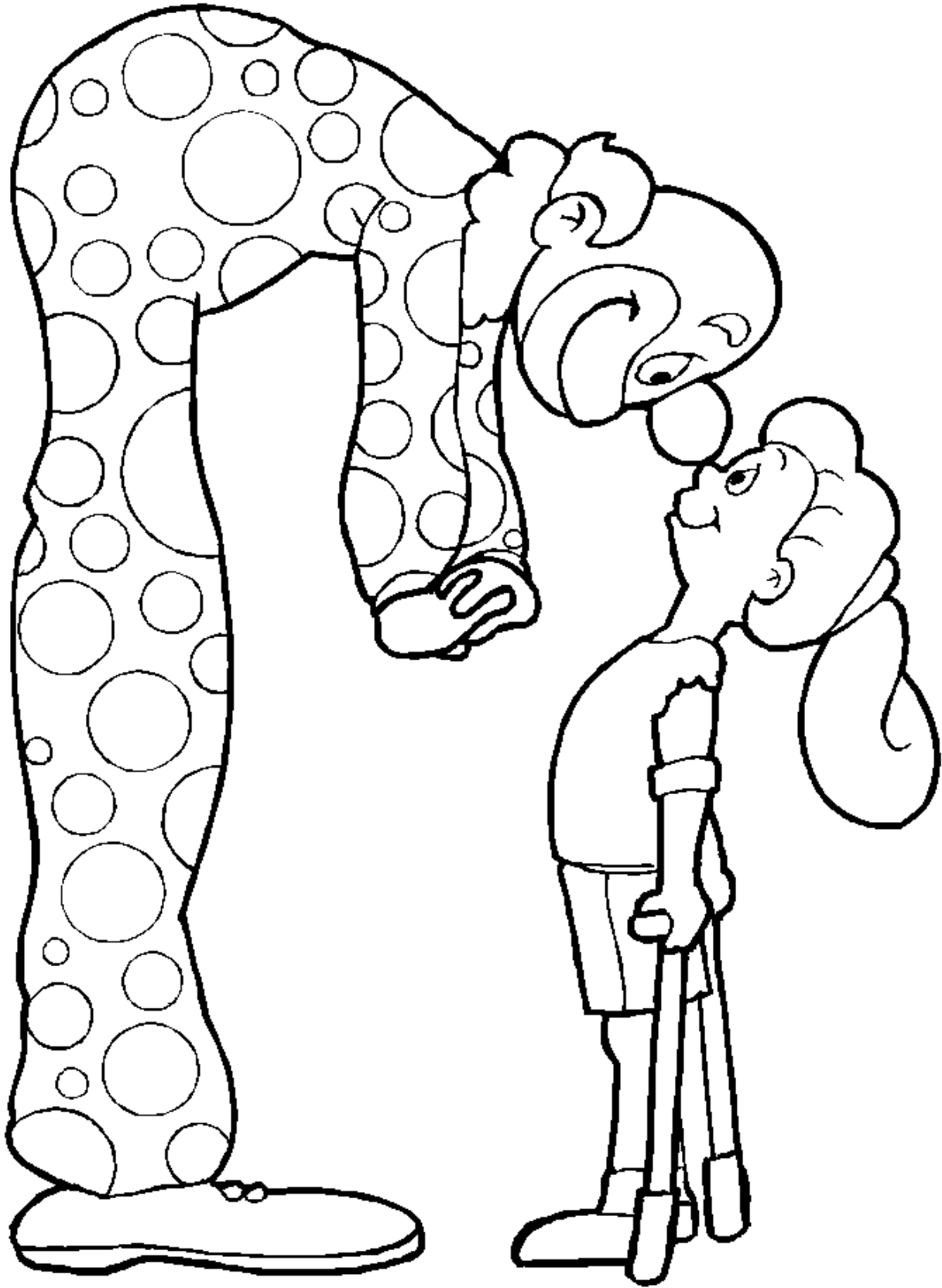
other children's eyes are **blue** or **brown** or **gray**, or **violet**.
